

## Munster To The Fore At Schools International Combined Events



The Schools International Combined Events Championships took place on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2018 in the Emirates Arena, Glasgow. The Irish Team won two individual silver medals (both won by Munster athletes) as well as silver team medals in the U16 Boys and Over 16 Girls & bronze team medals in the U16 Girls and Over 16 Boys.



Munster had 6 representatives on the Irish team with our best performances coming from **Laura Frawley, St. Mary's SC Charleville** who won individual silver in the U16 Girls competition finishing on

3328 points and **Harry Nevin, St. Francis' College Rochestown** who also won individual silver in the U16 Boys competition with 3294 points.

**Laura Frawley** led the Irish U16 Girl's team to a bronze medal finish with **Katie Nolke, Ursuline Waterford** in 10<sup>th</sup> place (3066 points) and 2<sup>nd</sup> scorer for the Irish team which finished on 9418 points behind Scotland in 2<sup>nd</sup> (9456 points) & England in gold medal position (9761 points).

**Harry Nevin** led the Irish U16 Boy's team to silver ably assisted by **Dillon Ryan, Thurles CBS** who was 8<sup>th</sup> with 2930 points making them 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> scorers for the Irish team. Their final score was 9169 points behind England (9616 points) with Wales in 3<sup>rd</sup> place on 9145 points).

The Over 16 Boys team won bronze on 10229 points. Munster's best finisher and Ireland's top scorer was **Wymin Sivakumar, Colaiste an Spioraid Naomh** who finished 6<sup>th</sup> with 3429 points with **Diarmuid O'Connor, Colaiste Choilm Ballincollig** in 15<sup>th</sup> place on 2181 points having suffered two disqualifications in the 200m and 800m for lane infringements. Scotland won the team competition with 10546 points with England 2<sup>nd</sup> on 10280 points.

## Irish team combine to win medals aplenty

The Irish schools' combined events team put in a strong showing at the Combined Events international in Glasgow on Saturday (November 3rd).

The junior girls' team put in solid performances to take bronze in the team standings. Laura Frawley (St.Mary's S.S. Charleville) took individual silver with 3,328 points.

The Irish team went one better in the intermediate girls standings winning silver with Chloe Casey (Saint Raphaels College, Loughrea) fourth individually scoring 3598 points.

In the boys, Ireland won team silver in the junior category with Harry Nevin (St. Francis College, Rochestown) also winning silver with 3294 points.

It was topped off with intermediate team bronze headed by Wymin Sivakumar (Colaiste an Spioraid Naoimh Bishopstown) scoring 3429 points in sixth.
